- Shaded area denotes unit that soldier was most likely in, based on pension file, service record or most reliable source.
 - The remains of James H. Purdom have been removed from the Geneva Cemetery. Records and pension files were not requested.
 - A family letter in the Geiger Genealogy Folder states that Jacob Saylor Geiger was not in any war. However, the WPA Grave registration shows that he did serve but not in the unit on his grave marker. The WPA record has proven the most accurate.
 - The George Heath in Co "I" 14th GA Inf. is actually a George D. Heath. George A. Heath was born in New York and first shows up in Geneva in the 1885 census as a Doctor along with a housekeeper, also from New York. His name is not listed in the WPA Grave Registration. It is unlikely that he served in the CSA.
 - The WPA Veterans Grave Registration was compiled during The Depression and reprinted in 1940-41.
 - Pension files are dated in early 1900's.
